FINANCIAL REPORT: December report and 2025 Draft Budget were shared. Finances continue in a downward trend overall. There was an approx. 24,000 deficit in 2024. Discussion on the current zoning restrictions and how that affects potential usage. Kindred works update: Katja had offered another session to meet in January. Since this offer was made, Katja notified that she will be leaving her position with Kindred Works. Discussion about the positive experience that was had through past meetings. 100 Year Anniversary Celebration: "What is Mount Royal doing to celebrate?". From now until the Anniversary there will be a monthly "100 Years" event or activity at Mount Royal. If joint service goes ahead, congregation encouraged to participate.
