Permission given to city contractors to store some material on grassy side of parking lot while construction is occurring. COMMUNICATIONS: Website draft was presented. Council approved continuing with this design. CHRISTIAN DEVELOPMENT/KIDS KORNER: Kids Korner season went well and that they had 4 regular attendees. CHAIR OF COUNCIL: Rotational schedule will be created for chairing council meetings. SELF ASSESSMENT: COPYRIGHT policy and recommendations will be presented at next meeting. INCLUSIVITY: Information will be shared throughout the year and next steps will be determined in Sept 2025. FINANCIAL STATEMENTS: Year end financial statements will be presented at June Meeting. MEMBERSHIP: Small committee will create plan to review/update/clean up rolls and directory in Sept 2024.
